Overheating Without Cause: While smartphones get warm with heavy use, unexplained overheating, especially when idle, could indicate hidden apps using power-intensive features like GPS tracking.

Strange Background Noises During Calls: Odd background noises, clicks, or static on your calls may mean your calls are tapped or recorded.

Random Reboots or Delays: Tracking software may cause system instability, leading to sudden reboots, app crashes, or slower performance.

Unknown Apps Installed: Spyware often installs itself secretly, so check your app list regularly. Any app you don't recognize could be
