Ransomware

Ransomware is a kind of malware that can be installed on a computer. It encrypts all the victims' personal data and prevents them from accessing it. The only way for them to get their computer back is by paying the ransom, often through cryptocurrency, to prevent it from being traced back to the hackers.

How does it work

The most common way ransomware is downloaded is through a phishing email. Once the link is clicked, it will automatically download the malware. Then, the data is encrypted.

Ransomware only needs access to your files to encrypt them and, in many cases, steal the data. Lastly, the hacker will request a ransom. The ransom note is built into the ransomware, often appearing in the computer's background or placed in each encrypted file.

- Double extortion
- Data encryption and theft
- Triple extortion
- Demanding ransom from the victim's customers or partners, as well as the victim
- Locker ransomware
- · Locks the computer instead of encrypting files
- Wiper
- Similar encryption technique, but wipes all the files from the computer
